12 September 2017

1) Recommendation and finalization of BDC Chair

The BDC meeting agreed to propose Mr. Supachok Jantarapatin as BDC Chair.

2) Update on e-Phytosanitary Certificate

Presented by Mr. Natthaphat Rojanasupamit

Mr. Natthaphat gave the presentation on the results of the questionnaire on Phytosanitary Certificate that aims to identify the readiness of AFACT member countries to exchange the Phytosanitary Certificate electronically. He also presented Thailand's progress in e-Phyto Certificate implementation which is planned to develop in July 2018.

The BDC meeting discussed how to exchange e-Phyto Certificate among AFACT members, and proposed the collaboration of e-Phyto data exchange between India and Thailand in which the details need to be discussed on both sides. Other AFACT members' participation is also welcomed.

3) “eWTP” (Electronic World Trade Platform) and Taiwan’s Customs Declaration Platform of Cross-border e-Commerce

Presented by Dr. Eva Yi-Yuan Yueh

Dr. Eva gave the presentation on eWTP (Electronic World Trade Platform) including its characteristics, objectives, obstacles/barriers, and other issues. She also presented Taiwan's Customs Declaration Platform for Imports/Exports of Cross-border e-Commerce including its scenario, key documents, and practical cases from different regions.

The BDC meeting concluded that AFACT members should discuss with their related organizations such as customs about the details of the business process of Customs Declaration related to goods imported via Cross-border e-Commerce channel. Also, AFACT members should find out related scenarios, key documents (such as Purchase order, Invoice and delivery note), and the classification code for e-Commerce product used in their country.

Existing scenarios and information collected from AFACT members shall be presented and discussed in the next BDC meeting or conference call if needed.
